

FRONTIER TOURING | EVENT SPECIFIC TERMS

These Event Specific Terms are to be read in conjunction with the Frontier Touring Terms of Sale and the Venue Terms and Conditions and may be updated from time to time.

EVENT NAME:	Arctic Monkeys
EVENT DATE & VENUE:	Saturday 14 January 2023 The Domain, Sydney
General Admission Event:	This is a fully general admission standing event. Front General Admission area (Front GA Area) is restricted to 16 and Over only. You will not be permitted into the Front GA Area if you are under 16 years of age.
Age Restrictions & Guidelines:	<p>All Ages</p> <p>The Event is an All Ages event, however, there are some restrictions to be aware of in order to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all patrons.</p> <p>Under 18s</p> <p>Event: Patrons under 18 years (Under 18s) must be accompanied at all times by a Responsible Adult.</p> <p>Responsible Adult for Under 18s means a person who holds a valid Event ticket and is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a parent or guardian of the Under 18; or (b) the spouse or de facto partner of the Under 18; or (c) for the time being standing in as the parent of the Under 18. <p>We strongly recommend this Responsible Adult is 25 years of age or older. A Responsible Adult may accompany a maximum of two (2) Under 18s at the Event. Any additional Under 18s will not be allowed into the Event without another accompanying Responsible Adult.</p> <p>Responsible Adults must be prepared for the responsibility of accompanying Under 18s by moderating their own alcohol intake and planning the day accordingly.</p> <p>The Responsible Adult must ensure that Under 18s in their care adhere to the Event Specific Terms. Failure to comply may result in the Responsible Adult and all accompanying Under 18s being removed from the Venue.</p> <p>Responsible Adults and Under 18s may be required to sign an "Accompanied Minor Form" so that in the event of an incident the Promoter has details on record.</p>
The Event is Licensed:	<p>Alcohol is not permitted to be brought into, or removed from, the Venue. Only alcohol purchased at the Venue may be consumed at the Venue in the permitted areas.</p> <p>Acceptable ID is required to purchase and consume alcohol at the Event. You must be 18 years or over to purchase and consume alcohol at the Venue. If you are found supplying or buying alcohol for an Under 18, you and the Under 18 will be evicted from the Venue and may be referred to police.</p> <p>There may be designated licensed areas to comply with relevant licensing laws applicable to the Venue.</p>
Acceptable ID:	<p>ID documents must be current and include a photo of the person and their date of birth.</p> <p>Acceptable ID means:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver Licence or Learner Permit (from any country) including Digital Driver Licences. • Passport (from any country). • KEYPASS Photo ID Card or Keypass in Digital iD • Any other recognised Proof/Evidence of Age/Identity or Photo Card.

	<p>All Acceptable ID must be written in English or if not written in English then accompanied by an official English translation.</p> <p>For a foreign Driver Licence not written in English, an International Driver Permit issued in the foreign country of origin (and including a photo of the licence holder and translation) should be presented with the Foreign Driver Licence.</p>
Bags:	<p>Backpacks of any size are not permitted.</p> <p>We encourage patrons not to bring any bags, however, small bags up to the Maximum Allowed Bag Size are permitted.</p> <p>Maximum Allowed Bag Size is 30cm x 30cm x 10cm.</p> <p>All patrons with bags will be subject to bag checking and other security measures upon arrival at the Venue.</p> <p>Please arrive early to ensure that you have plenty of time to proceed through security checks and any required check-in points prior to entering the Venue.</p>
Box Office Collections:	<p>If you are collecting tickets from the Box Office you need Acceptable ID.</p> <p>You also need to bring the credit card used to purchase the tickets.</p>
Pass Outs:	<p>No pass-outs are available at the Event.</p>
Smoking and Vaping:	<p>Most Venues operate a <i>No Smoking + No Vaping</i> policy and you must comply with any such policy.</p> <p>If a Venue does permit smoking and/or vaping it will be clearly signposted and there will be designated areas in the Venue and smoking and vaping will be permitted in those designated areas, subject to applicable laws in place at the time of the Event.</p>
Weather:	<p>The Event is an all-weather event and will proceed rain or shine.</p> <p>Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance so be prepared.</p> <p>Umbrellas, tents and sunshades are not permitted in the Venue, so bring a raincoat or poncho if there is inclement weather.</p>
Food & Drink:	<p>Water</p> <p>There will be free water stations at the Venue.</p> <p>Patrons may bring in an EMPTY translucent (clear) refillable plastic water bottle. NO GLASS OR METAL BOTTLES ARE ALLOWED.</p> <p>Beverages</p> <p>No other beverages may be brought into the Venue.</p> <p>Food</p> <p>No food can be brought into the Venue except patrons with special dietary requirements may bring their own food.</p>
Prohibited Items:	<p>In addition to any Prohibited Items listed in the Event Terms of Sale or the Venue Terms and Conditions the following are not permitted into the Venue:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Air horns, whistles, hooters and megaphones. • Alcohol - any alcohol found at the Venue will be confiscated and will not be returned and the offending patron(s) ejected from Venue for the remainder of the Event. • Animals (excluding service dogs such as guide dogs and police or emergency service dogs). • Anything studded (ie belts, wristbands etc). • Audio or video recording devices (including <i>GoPro</i> and similar). • Backpacks of any size. • Bags larger than 30cm x 30cm x 10cm. • Banners, posters, flags (no poles) or signs larger than 30cm x 30cm (content must not be offensive in nature). • Beverages (both alcoholic and non-alcoholic) - there will be free water refill stations available at the Venue. • Cans • Chairs, folding chairs, bean bags, inflatable chairs or lounges, tables, cushions or blankets of any kind.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothing, jewellery or accessory displaying the name of any motorcycle-related or similar organisations or any “declared criminal organisation” within the meaning of the Criminal Code (Criminal Organisations) Regulation 2013. • Confetti or shredded paper. • Drones or other remote-control devices. • Eskies, coolers or any hard food and beverage storage vessels. • Fires and open flames. • Flammable liquids. • Flares, fireworks, sparklers, explosives, or any fire twirling equipment. • Food (except as outlined above in Food & Drink). • Glass (jars, bottles, containers, mirrors, perfumes, etc). • Hydration packs and reservoirs (eg Camelbaks). • Illegal substances. • iPads and tablets. • Kites or sky lanterns. • Metal and hard plastic containers (drink bottles, cups, etc). • Monopods, tripods or attachment sticks (selfie-sticks). • Musical instruments. • Nitrous oxide bulbs and canisters. • Portable laser equipment, laser pointers and pens. • Prams, pushers, strollers, baby capsules, car seats or bassinets. • Professional photography equipment (eg telephoto lenses; any lens over 20cm; any detachable lens; stands or other commercial equipment or anything deemed by Event staff to be professional photography equipment) Flash photography is not permitted. • Sharpies, markers, paint cans or paint pens. • Skateboards, scooters, wagons, carts, rollerblades, roller skates, electric bikes, bicycles, quad-bikes, segways, hoverboards, self-balancing scooters or any personal motorised vehicles. • Sound systems. • Toy guns, water guns or slingshots. • Umbrellas, tents and sunshades. • Unauthorised solicitation materials including handbills, flyers, stickers, beach balls, give-aways, samples, or other promotional items. • Weapons or explosives of any kind (including potential missiles). • Any other item deemed by Event staff (in their discretion) to be dangerous or offensive or potentially dangerous. <p>Any Prohibited Items will be confiscated. Confiscated items will not be returned, replaced or reimbursed.</p>
<p>Variation to Event Specific Terms</p>	<p>Frontier may vary these Event Specific Terms at any time without notice to you. Any variations become effective immediately once the variation has been published on Frontier’s website. Any variations will not operate retrospectively.</p>
<p>Enforceability</p>	<p>Any provision of these Event Specific Terms which is or becomes unenforceable shall not invalidate the other provisions of these Event Specific Terms.</p>
